

Consent for Dental Treatment

Family Health is committed to improving dental health in our community and establishing a dental home for every child.

During your child's first visit, they will meet Dr. Dajani and her staff. At this appointment, Dr. Dajani will explain any necessary dental procedures to both you and your child. Our goal is to provide your child with a friendly and enjoyable experience.

Please review the following procedures that are usually completed:

- Comprehensive exam (the evaluation of the growth and development of your child's teeth)
- Review of diet and oral hygiene instructions
- Radiographs as recommended by the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry (www.aapd.org)
- Cleaning
- Evaluation for fluoride treatment as recommended by the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry.
- Establish a plan of care according to your child's future dental needs.
- Dr. Dajani will evaluate your child to create an individualized health plan that ensures their comfort during dental visits. This plan may include options such as oral sedation (also known as "sleepy juice"), laughing gas, or, in some cases, medication prescribed before the appointment. Younger children, as well as those with certain medical conditions or significant tooth decay, may need to be seen by Dr. Dajani at Dayton Children's Hospital, where the dental work can be completed under general anesthesia.
